

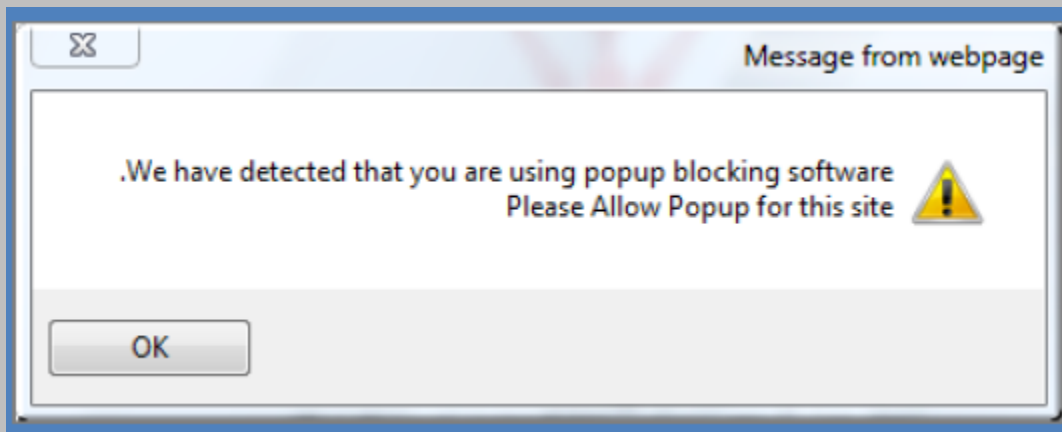
## Pop-ups

Pop-ups are a form of online advertising on the World Wide Web intended to attract web traffic or to capture email addresses and it can annoy the user, thus most of browsers were endowed with tools to hinder these pop ups. The pop-up window containing an advertisement is usually generated by JavaScript using cross-site scripting (XSS).

Sometimes when you log into highly sensitive websites with privacy concerns regarding database; these pop ups pops on to protect these information from threats generated by other vulnerabilities/security holes in browser security.

The portal's systems have adopted this technology to maintain client's information security protection. Therefore whenever a user arrives at the portal his information will be in the portal's safeguard in a secured zone and there would be no way for hack works.

Dear portal's client, you might be disturbed by the following pop up box whenever you try to login to the system:



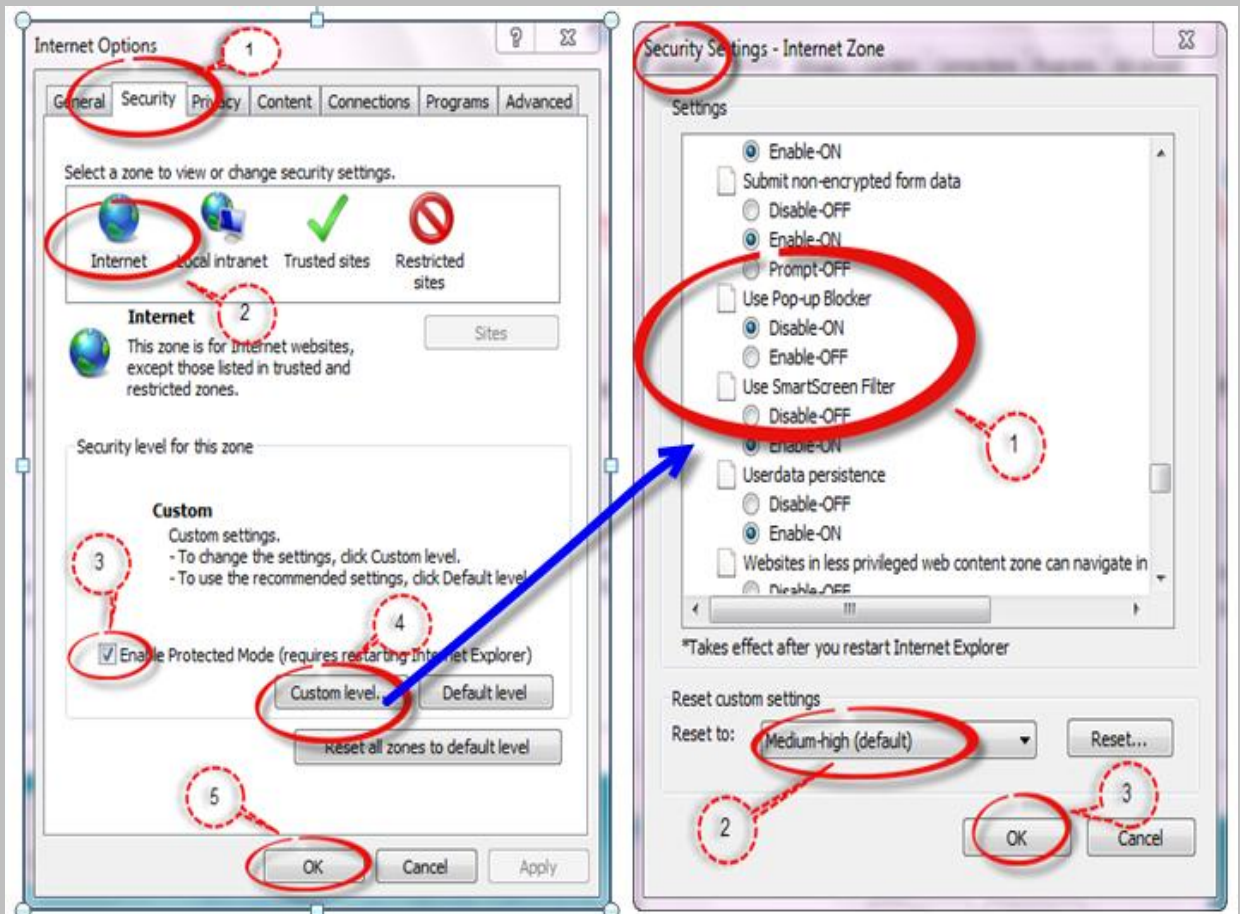

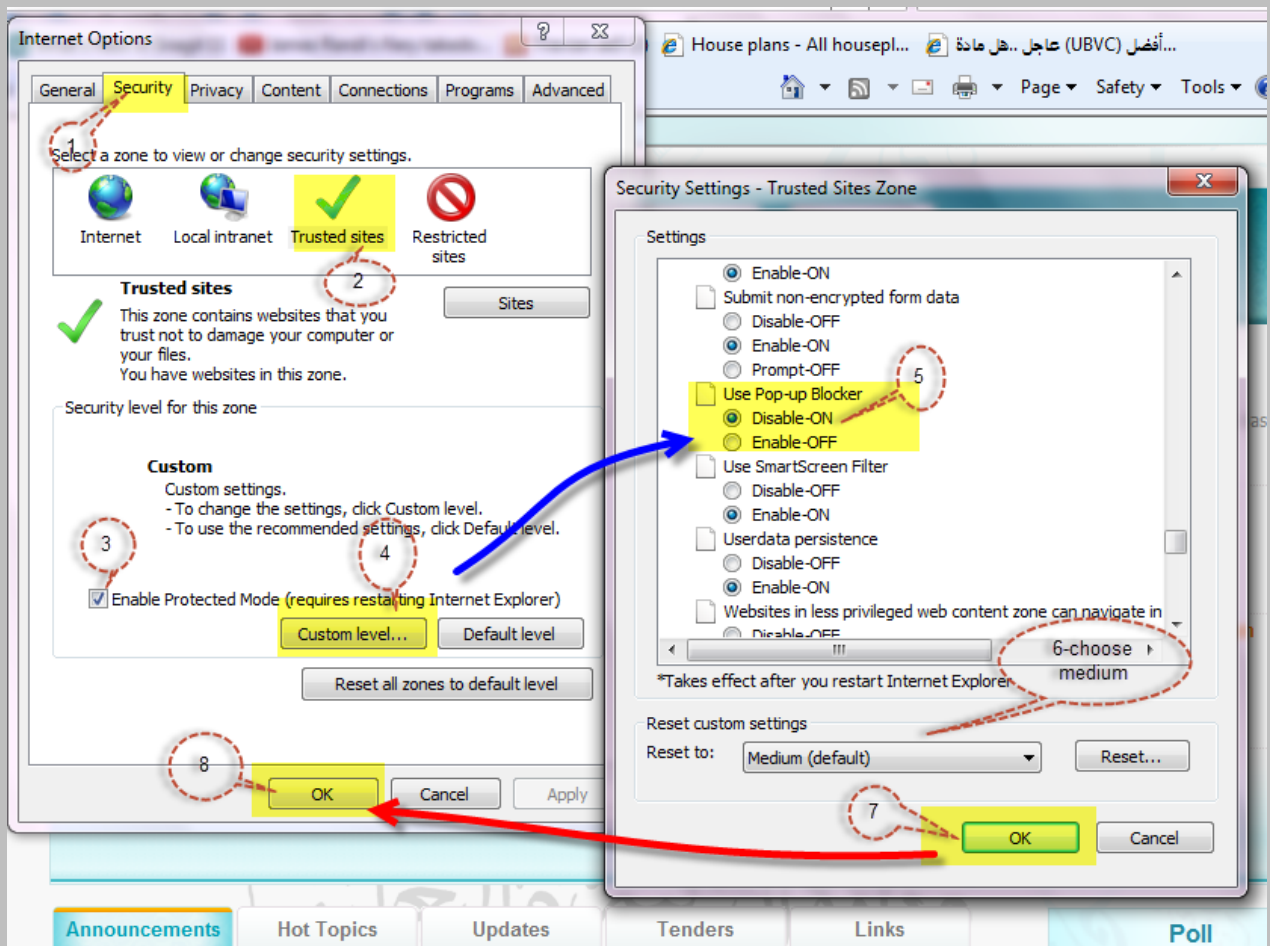
## Security/ Internet –Pop ups

In step 3 , Click on - *sites* – a new window will open for you, type in the website address then click *add*

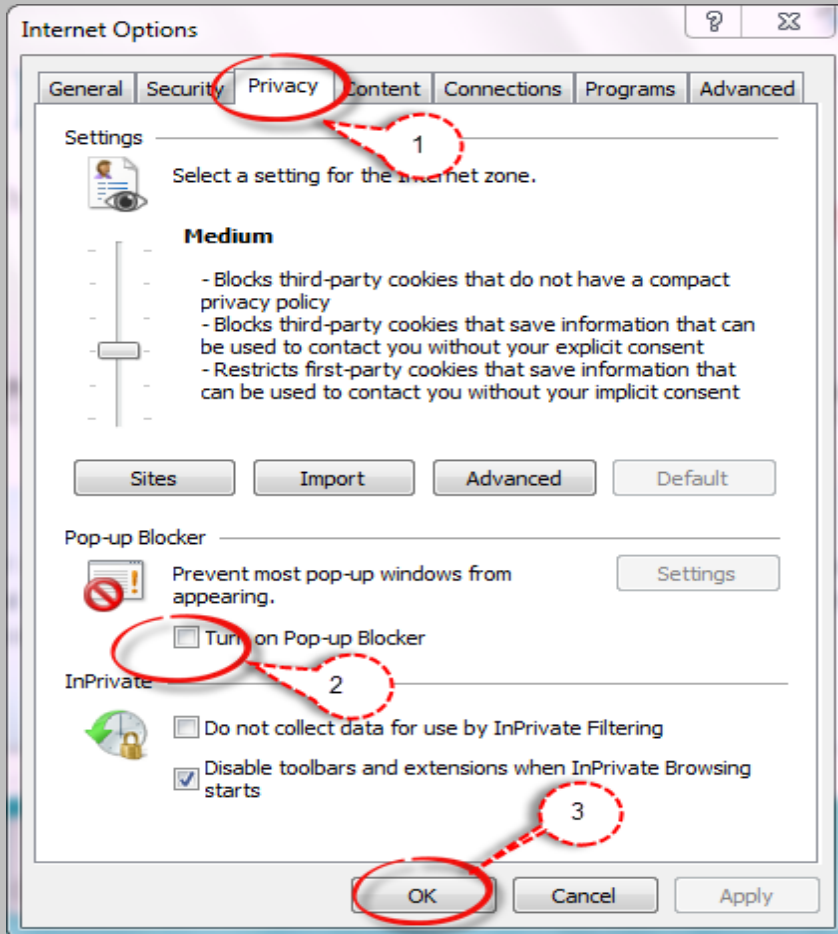

**Internet Options - Security Tab:**

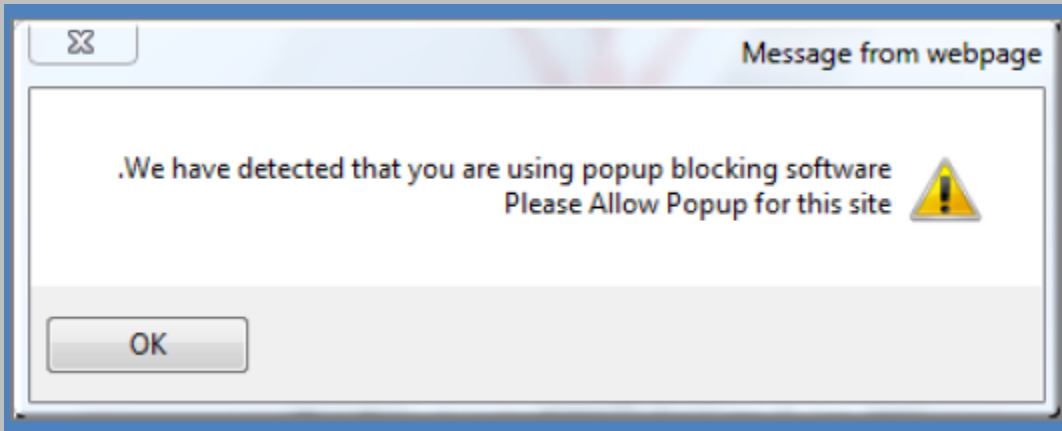
- 1. Select the 'Trusted sites' zone.
- 2. Click the 'Sites' button.
